Model 35 Microphone Stand Mounting Adapter Assembly Notes

Attaching the Bracket


Each Model 35 Talent Amplifier includes a microphone stand adapter, knurled clamp screw, and two mounting screws.

The two 6-32 by 3/8-inch truss-head phillips screws attach the mounting adapter to the cover of the Model 35 Talent Amplifier. Refer to the figure below for details on how to orient the bracket onto the cover.

Note: When using the mounting adapter, it is intended for the Model 35 to be parallel to the stand's vertical tube. This results in the controls and headphone jacks being at the top, and the 3-pin XLR-type cable(s) exiting straight out the bottom toward the floor. For maximum stability and safety, the adapter was specifically designed to be parallel to the Model 35's cover, and not be at an angle.

Design Notes

The mounting adapter was specifically designed to protect the finish of your chromeplated or painted microphone stands. The entire adapter is dipped in plastic to protect anything that the adapter comes in contact with. The 1/4-20 by 3/4-inch knurled roundhead screw that clamps the adapter onto a microphone stand is not a "cheap" plastic part, but was specifically selected not to cause scratches. It is made of nylon and is very strong; we weren't able to break it during testing. (Please don't try to prove us wrong by abusing it!) We were tired of seeing expensive microphone stands damaged by poorly designed clamps. We hope you find our solution a good one.
